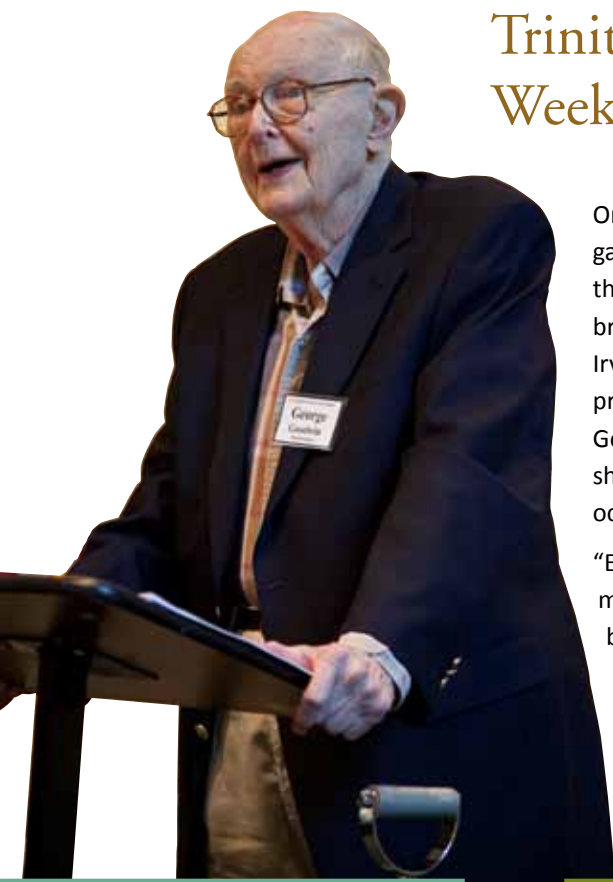

## Trinity Men Celebrate 10th Anniversary of Weekly Breakfast Gathering



On Friday, April 29, more than 60 men gathered in Williams Hall to celebrate the tenth anniversary of their weekly breakfast gathering. Trinity member Mac Irvin served as moderator of the morning program, and several men, including George Goodwin and Jerry Schueneman, shared their thoughts on the landmark occasion.

“Each of us comes for reasons that may be different from the others’, but to worry about the differences would miss the point that there are significant, unifying reasons this group has gathered today and has done so regularly for the past 10 years.” said George Goodwin.

Since 2001 the men of Trinity have met each and every Friday morning to share a meal, a time of devotion and fellowship. Throughout the years, the men have shared stories of their faith, careers, and interests and have welcomed others to do the same. As George said to those gathered on the anniversary morning, “For although we know we have something special here, we enthusiastically encourage other men to join us and be a part of it. The welcome mat is always out.”

## Become a Meals on Wheels Volunteer

Do you have 2 hours to spare each month?? Drivers are needed for the Meals on Wheels Program. We have lost a couple of our regular drivers, and it is becoming a challenge to cover all the days.

Volunteers deliver meals (prepared by Senior Connections) from Trinity five days a week to clients in the Bolton Road area. Volunteers drive in pairs (women, men, couples). Most have a scheduled day while others "float" and are assigned each month. The prepared meals are picked up in a cooler at Trinity about 10:00 am. The same route, which serves six clients, is driven each day. The route takes about one hour, depending on how long the drivers visit with the clients.

The cooler is then returned to Trinity. Trinity has had a long-standing partnership with Senior Citizens Service, dating back to 1993. They hire the meal providers and supply the case managers, who determine the clients served.

The MOW program was one of the original hands-on projects at Trinity. Some of our teams have been delivering 14 years. We currently have 40 active volunteers. The core group of drivers is stable, but there is always a need for new volunteers for the regular schedule, or to be on the substitute list. You are encouraged to give it a try, to see if it is a hands-on service you would enjoy.

## Give, Act, Pray

### PRESBYTERIAN DISASTER ASSISTANCE

The effects of this year's spring storms continue to affect many states; severe storms and tornadoes caused widespread damage and destruction. As we pray for all who have been affected by these events, we remember that "Our help is in the name of the Lord, who made heaven and earth" (Psalm 124:8), and call on the saving power of the Lord Jesus Christ, whom "even the winds and sea obey" (Matthew 8:27).

One Great Hour of Sharing and designated funds from PDA are already at work in at least 17 presbyteries this spring, as they address disasters within their areas.

**May 23, 2011** - A tornado in Joplin, Missouri, caused major damage and left dozens of people dead. PDA will provide an update as soon as more information is available.

**May 17, 2011** - Extensive flooding in major cities has also affected many smaller communities; PDA is thankful for Gift of the Heart kits, including clean-up buckets, which are greatly needed.

**May 12, 2011** - Damage from extensive flooding is not yet fully known; Gift of the Heart Kits have been distributed; PDA will work with presbyteries as they look toward recovery and rebuilding.

**May 4, 2011** - Mayfield, New York, Presbyterian Church was destroyed, but congregation will continue to feed the hungry in their community.

**April 29, 2011** - Churches are damaged; PDA is responding in multiple presbyteries.

**April 28, 2011** - numerous tornadoes occur across the southern states including Alabama; NRT is serving in 11 presbyteries.

**April 18, 2011** - Weekend tornadoes occur in North Carolina and Virginia.

To support the relief and recovery ministry, designate gifts with "DR000015, U.S. Disasters" on the memo line.
