## Trinity Explores! New Class Begins September 11



Trinity Explores! is a 4-week program of community classes offered at 7 p.m. on Thursdays during September and October. The program consists of a continuing series of courses of the highest quality, similar to those already offered in the Sunday church school curriculum at Trinity, but expanded beyond Sunday and beyond the current Trinity audience. The purpose of this undertaking is to enhance opportunities for Christian education, faith development and the study of spiritual and values-related subjects, both for Trinity members who already avail themselves of the Adult Education offerings, and for members and non-members not currently active in Trinity educational programs.

Beginning Thursday, September 11, Dr. Carl Holladay, Professor of New Testament at Emory University's Candler School of Theology, will lead an in-dept study of the Gospel of Luke. This course is your chance to engage in a serious, rigorous exploration of the subtleties, nuances, and deep meanings of Luke's gospel with one of today's foremost experts on Luke-Acts.

Dr. Holladay's scholarship focuses on New Testament themes, with an emphasis on Luke-Acts. He received his B.A. from Abilene Christian University, his Th.M. from Princeton Theological Seminary, and his Ph.D. from the University of Cambridge, England. Recent works include *Biblical Exegesis: A Beginner's Handbook* and *A Critical Introduction to the New Testament: Interpreting the Message and Meaning of Jesus Christ*.
